a. Technological Medical Advancements White Paper

Chairman Swindell introduced the Technological Medical Advancements White Paper which was reviewed by TRAC and the recommendation was positive.

A motion to approve Resolution 2020-01 approving Technological Medical Advancements, LLC as a Tenant in the Research Park at Florida Atlantic University was made by Mr. Daszkal and seconded by Mr. Yentz. The motion passed 6-0, with 1 member absent.

b. Economic Development Agreement with the City of Boca Raton

The economic development agreement with the City of Boca Raton is favorable and similar to what past agreements: it is an investment of \$150,000 to support the soft landing initiative. The Authority looks forward to continued work with the City of Boca Raton.

A motion to approve Resolution 2020-02 approving the agreement between the City of Boca Raton and Florida Atlantic Research and Development Authority was made by Mr. Yentz and seconded by Dr. Salazar. The motion passed 6-0, with 1 member absent.

c. Keefe McCullough engagement letter and agreement to provide external audit services

A motion to approve Resolution 2020-03 approving the agreement between Keefe McCullough & Co., LLP and Florida Atlantic Research and Development Authority was made by Dr. Salazar and seconded by Mr. Rosetto. The motion passed 6-0, with 1 member absent.

d. Kayne Anderson proposal to acquire KFH's sub-subleasehold and interest of KFH in the Research Park at FAU.

Representatives of Kayne Anderson presented their plan to develop the Research Park at Florida Atlantic University, to include approximately 1,500,000 square feet of additional space for medical arts, FAU medical facilities, student housing, general office, retail and hotel & conference center.

The City of Boca Raton Deputy City Manager expressed concern about the intensity of development and the additional demand for services and infrastructure.

Members questioned whether student housing is an appropriate use in a research and development park on state land. Members questioned Page 4 of 6

whether student housing or retail could be considered ancillary or complementary uses if either were 20 – 25 percent of total overall development.

Mr. Pincus discussed his analysis of the request to pre-approve development, reminding members of the statutory definition of a research and development park and the Authority's responsibility outlined in the Authority's lease with the state, quoting Section 4 of the leases between the State of Florida and the Authority, in part:

"The Park Lands shall be used, developed, managed and operated by the Authority for research, design, development, testing, educational, limited production, and other activities compatible with research, both basic and applied, in furtherance of the essential public purposes declared by the enabling legislation ... Authority shall have full and sole control of and responsibility for the development, subleasing, management, and use of the Park Lands and for the negotiation, consummation and enforcement of all contracts and agreements relating thereto. It is expressly provided, however, that the Authority shall at all times use its best efforts to protect the Park Lands against unauthorized activities and influences which are inconsistent with the character of the Park Lands as a research and development park."

FAU General Counsel, Mr. David Kian told the Authority that the University had many of the same questions members were asking, and appreciated the members' enthusiasm for the potential of new capital and activity coming to the Research Park at FAU, but caution and deliberation being exhibited.

The consensus of the members was to ask Mr. Duffell and Mr. Pincus to work with Kayne Anderson to bring a revised proposal, in the form of a draft resolution, back to the Authority for review. Members suggested that the overall percentage of housing be lowered, and the definition of housing be expressed. A desire to see some time milestones was expressed, as was a way to ensure the Authority retained its ability to review and approve projects and development. All discussions should involve the City of Boca Raton as well because, in all likelihood, a new interlocal agreement between the City and Authority will be needed if development on the scale being discussed is approved.

e. Extension of agreement with Stearns Weaver

A motion to approve direct Mr. Duffell to extend the agreement for legal services with Stearns Weaver et al. for one (1) year, as described in Section

3.2 of the agreement, was made by Dr. Salazar and seconded by Mr. Rosetto. The motion passed 6-0, with 1 member absent.
